GCSE Results 2009

Lakers School turns in yet another set of exceptional GCSE results. The Fisher family trust 'D' predictor for this year group – the toughest measure of potential - indicated that 53.1% of students might achieve 5 A* to C grades at GCSE. Lakers students have exceeded this prediction by achieving an excellent 54% with 5 A* to C grades. This is a fantastic achievement for our students, many of whom are very modest and self-effacing. The critical government measure of 5 A* to C including English and maths sees 40% of Lakers students achieving to the highest standard. Lakers has achieved an improvement of 6% over last year's results despite last year's students being of technically higher academic ability.

Congratulations to all students, staff and parents who have worked hard and so supportively of each other to prepare all students for a successful future. We look forward to focusing all our efforts on building on this success again next year.
